PHASE I SNOW REMOVAL

Michigan City, IN -- Mayor Chuck Oberlie and James T. Elwell, Superintendent of Central Services, issued the following statement today:

“Effective immediately, a Phase I Snow Removal has been declared and will remain in effect until further notice.”

Mayor Oberlie said, “Street Department employees began working around the clock at 7:00 p.m. Monday evening and will continue around the clock as required. Plowing crews will concentrate on snow routes until the snowfall ends. Due to a limited supply of de-icing materials, salt and sand will be used on intersections and on hills.”

The Phase I Snow Removal Condition places a parking ban on both sides of all identified Snow Routes and on the north and west side of all other remaining city streets.

Mayor Oberlie asks for the cooperation of all citizens so that roadways can be kept open for everyone’s convenience and safety.
